Lions Clubs offer young people in their local areas this unique opportunity to participate too. The experience and feedback the Clubs routinely receive back from all who participate is amazing and friendships are often formed for life. The Ringwood and Fordingbridge Club is looking forward to hearing back from Isabelle about her three centre experience in Hong Kong, China and Macau, Katie about her scheduled trip to the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum in Japan or from Rosalyn about how she got on with her three-day training in a beautiful traditional schooner in Finland. Every trip is unique and each young persons spends up to two weeks living with a host family and then a further week to ten days at an International Youth Camp comprising young people from around the words.

Every year more than 100 International Youth Camps are arranged by Lions Clubs International spanning 40 different countries. Every Lions Camp is different and exciting and offers everyone participating a life changing experience; to explore the cuture and sights of that country; to be more independent; and to make new friends around the world. Ommonly, those taking part will only need to raise enough funds for their flights and spending money with Lions Clubs in the country they are visiting meeting other expenses.



Any Club can get involved and often it takes only a short presentation at a local school to spark enthusiasm and questions from students eager to find out more. This wonderful scheme underpins the global nature of Lions Clubs International with friendship and exclusivity at its very heart.
